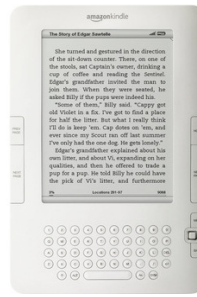


Got a Kindle?



You Can Download EBooks Free of Charge from the Library!

When you first purchase a Kindle, set it up and register with Amazon. The Kindle is then linked to one Amazon.com account. That account is the one that must be used when downloading books to the Kindle. If the book is being downloaded to a Kindle app on a phone or other device- any log in can be used, and it will immediately download.

Please keep in mind that a Wi-Fi connection is needed for Kindle downloads. If you do not have Wi-Fi service at home you can download your Kindle book onto a USB drive and manually upload it to your Kindle. Or, you can stop in the library and take advantage of our free Wi-Fi connection!

Visit the Library's homepage: <http://www.portjefflibrary.org> and click on the "Live-brary" link to get started. Once on the Live-brary homepage, click on "Free Downloads". Each title will indicate if it is available in Kindle format. If the book you are looking for is currently checked out, you can put in on hold. When it becomes available you will be emailed.

EBooks can have long waiting lists just like their print versions. Please be patient.

If your book is available, follow the steps below to download it to your Kindle:

1. Once your book is selected and it is available in Kindle format click "add to cart" (to the right of the ebook format type).
2. The Shopping Cart will open. If you would like to add additional titles, click "continue browsing", or if you are finished, click "Proceed to checkout".
3. On the checkout page you will be instructed to select The Port Jefferson Free Library from a pull down menu. Then input your library barcode (the number on the back of your library card).
4. Select your loan period- either 7 days or 14 days.
5. Click "Confirm Check Out".
6. Once the book is checked out, click "Get for Kindle" button on the upper right side which will bring you to Amazon.com You must download your Kindle EBook from Amazon.com.
7. Click "Get Library Book" button. You will be asked to sign in to your Amazon.com account. When signing in to Amazon.com the account used must be the one to which the Kindle is registered (as explained above).
8. Once you have signed in you must select which device to which you would like your book downloaded. Options include the Kindle itself as well as various Kindle apps.
9. Once you have selected your device the next screen will appear to confirm its download.
